The Environment Trust for Richmond upon Thames is a registered charity and was set up in 1984 to preserve and find new community-based uses for buildings and landscapes of historic and social significance in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames.

We currently look after several sites in the borough, including Grove Gardens Chapel in Richmond (a Grade II listed building that the Trust rescued from dereliction in the 1990s), the grounds around Kilmorey Mausoleum on the border of St Margarets and Isleworth (which are being turned into a thriving wildlife garden by dedicated volunteers), and Vineyard Passage Burial Ground in Richmond. We are also involved in campaigns to restore the explorer Sir Richard Burton's tomb in Mortlake and to preserve a 1930s air-raid shelter in East Sheen. Recent successes include securing the future of the grade II listed printer's shop at 8 King Street in Richmond, which was in a derelict state and at risk of insensitive redevelopment.

In addition to direct action to preserve and care for these buildings and open spaces, the Trust also aims to enthuse people about the environment around them through practical conservation work and educational events, such as our popular Art Picnics - a series of 1-day drawing and painting events at various locations around the borough and further afield, with tuition from professional artists, enabling participants to enhance their creative skills while studying and exploring the particular features of each site.

The next big project on the Trust's horizon is an educational River Centre for the whole community in the heart of Twickenham, as part of the redevelopment of Twickenham Riverside. The River Centre will provide education and entertainment related to the river, the local environment and wider issues of climate change and sustainability, as well as play facilities and a café/restaurant where people can sit and enjoy the river.

By becoming a member of the Environment Trust, you will be showing your support for the conservation and educational work that we do and enable us to continue to identify and protect sites that might otherwise be lost forever through neglect or insensitive redevelopment. In return, we will provide you with regular newsletters about our activities and the opportunity to learn more about your neighbourhood, including occasional visits to buildings of interest and other events throughout the year.
